**SURVEY ON THE STATUS AND CONDITIONS OF MANUFACTURING LICENSES UNDER THE
INDUSRIAL COORDINATION ACT 1975**

The Ministry of Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI) and the Malaysian Investment Development Authority (MIDA) are currently collecting data on the status and conditions of the Manufacturing License which is issued by MITI since 2016. MITI has advised that by 31 December 2024, companies must comply with condition of full-time employment of at least 80% of Malaysians (80:20 ruling).

Objective: The objective of this survey is to collect data on the status and conditions of the manufacturing license which will help MITI and MIDA to plan and implement policies in line with the interests of the industry and national development.

Target: The target is companies that have received the Manufacturing License approval and are subject to the requirement of full-time employment of at least 80% Malaysians. Companies not subject to the above-mentioned requirement are also welcome to submit their feedback to this survey.
