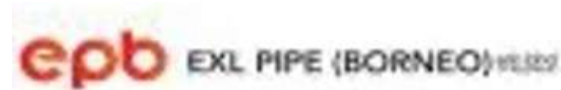

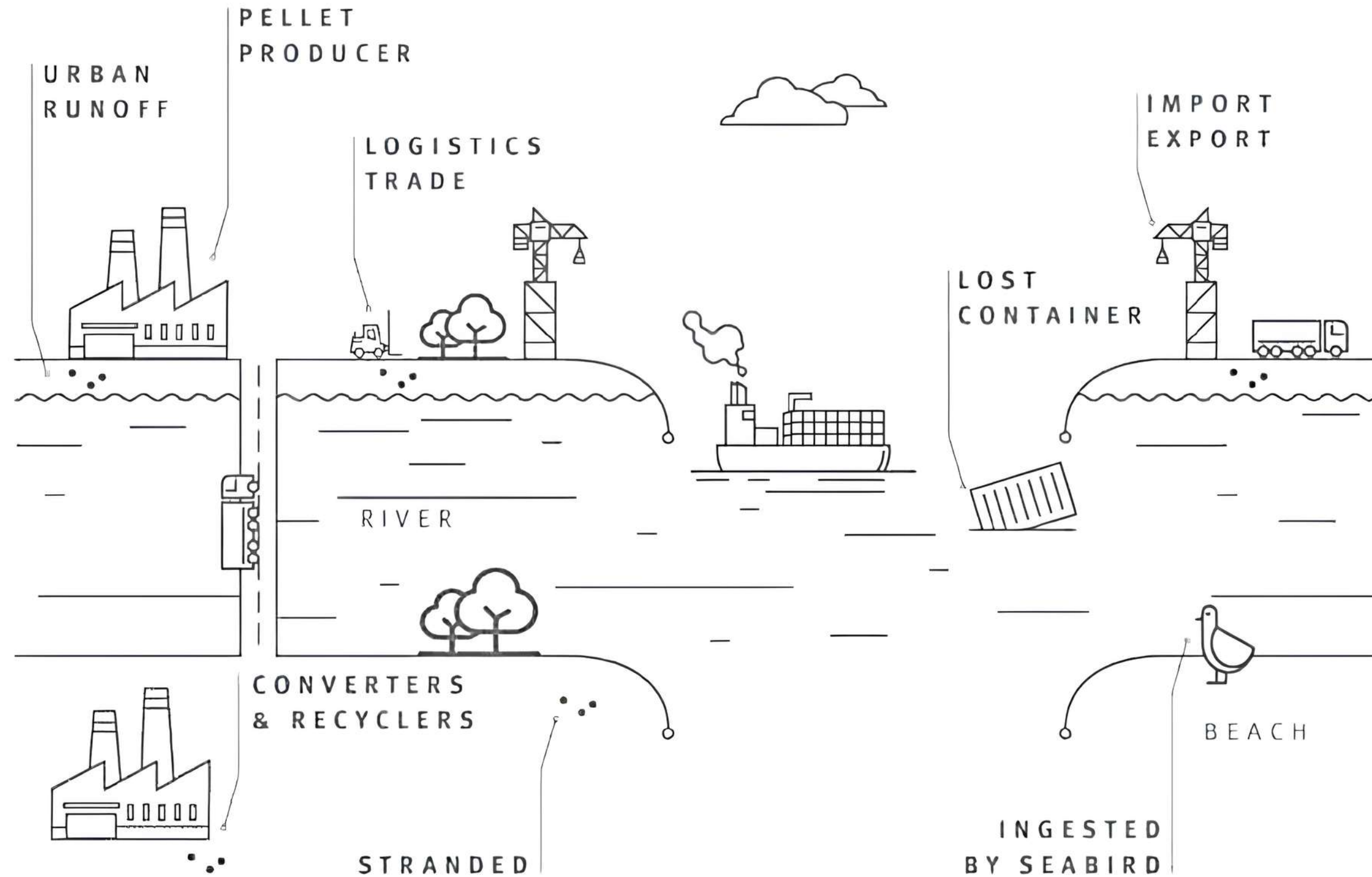


A CALL TO ACTION

Resin pellets, flakes and powder that enter the waste stream can end up in the ocean and our natural environment. These pellets, flakes and powder may be accidentally eaten by wildlife. The impacts of ingested marine debris on the ecosystem can be significant and warrant efforts to prevent plastic materials from entering the environment.

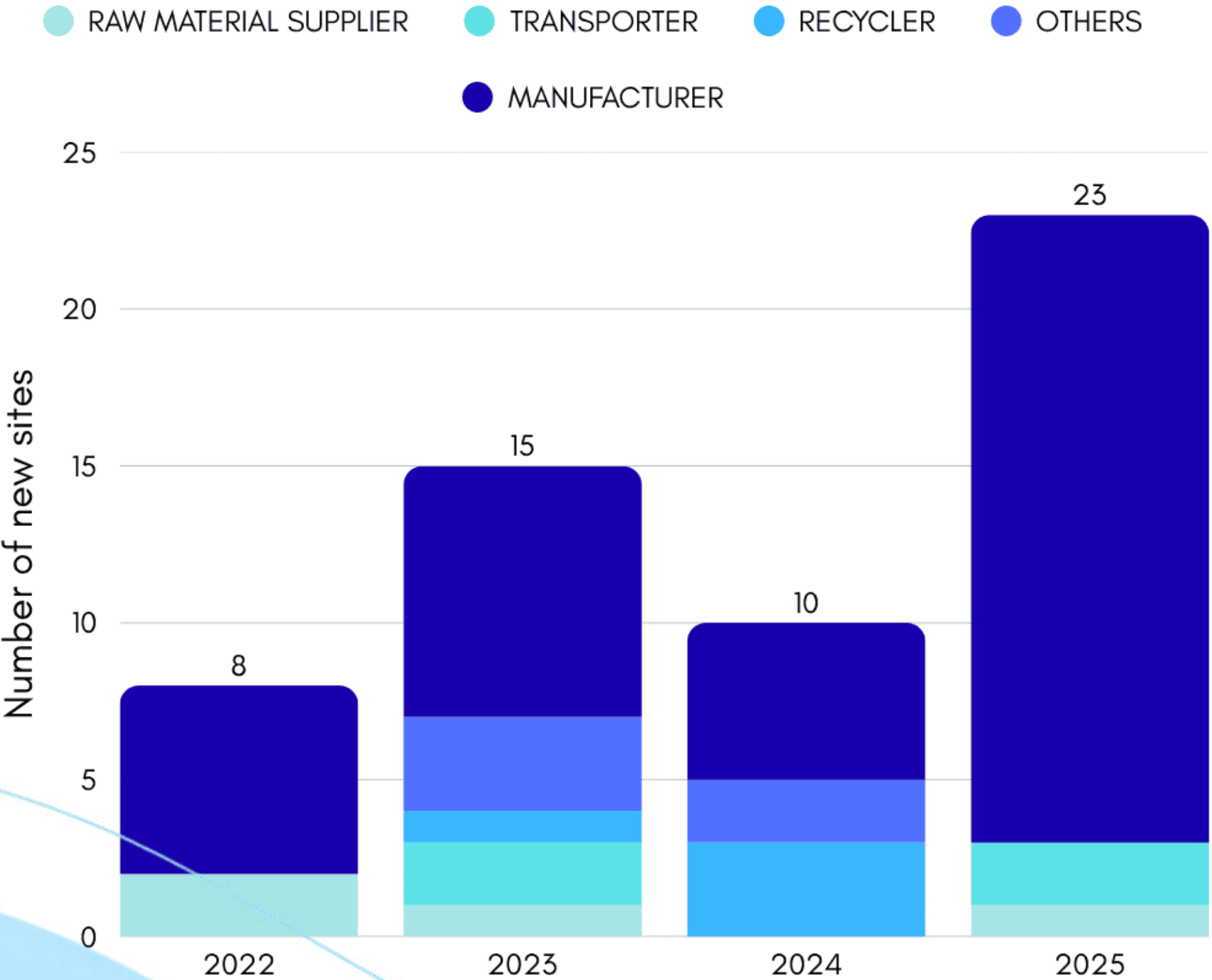

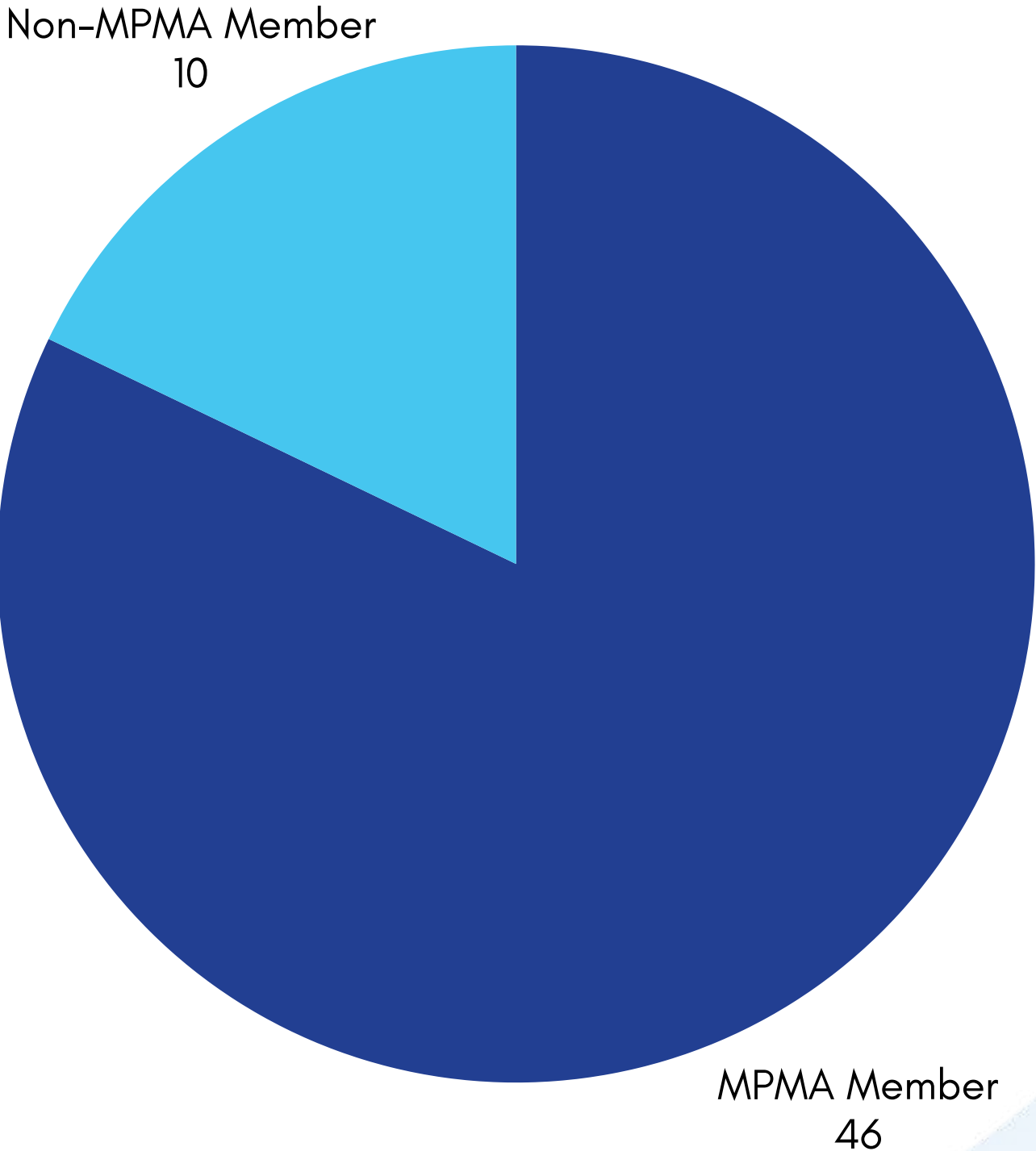

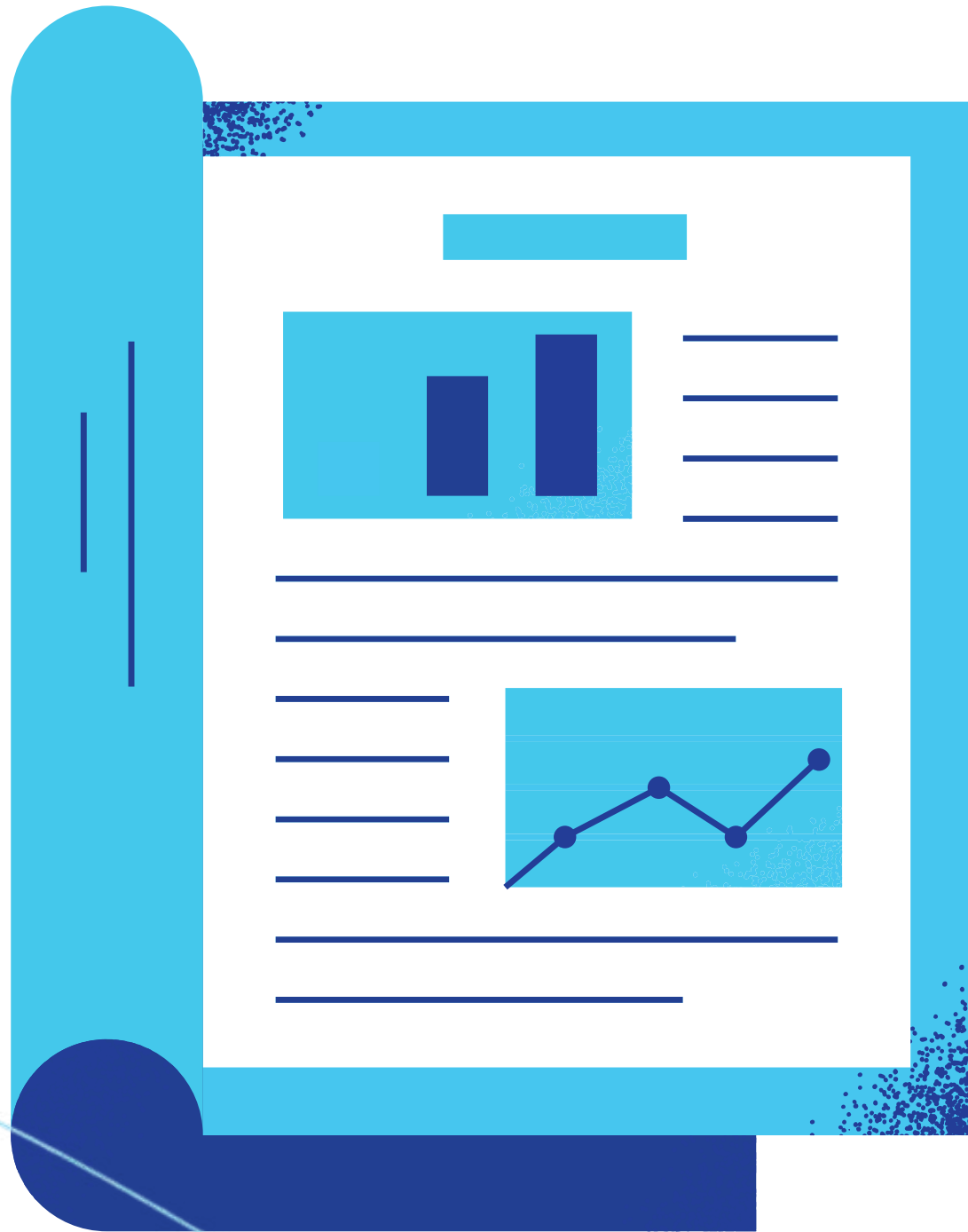
