- Perform duties as OSH-Coordinator in an organisation
- Understand the legal requirement of Occupational Safety and Health Act
- Promote safety culture at the workplace
- Take reasonable action pertaining to OSH compliance
- Manage and maintain OSH documents.

Eligibility:

- Malaysian Citizens
- 18 years old and above
- Able to read and write in Bahasa Malaysia and English
- Preferable a member of Safety Committee

The Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Bill 2020 ("OSH (Amendment) Bill 2020") was passed by the Dewan Rakyat (House of Representatives) and the Dewan Negara (Senate) and had received the Royal Assent on 4 March 2022.

The key changes under the Amended OSHA are:

- Employers with five or more employees must employ and train OSH Coordinator
- Penalty of failing to appoint an OSH Coordinator, or an SHO (where applicable) is a fine not exceeding RM50,000.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or both
