APPROVAL FOR OPERATING DURING THE MCO FOR PHASE 1 AND 2 IS STILL VALID FOR PHASE 3

Reference is made to [MITI's Press Statement](#), Tuesday, 14 April 2020, 2.45 pm. The Ministry of International Trade & Industry (MITI) announced that the approval MITI has given to companies to operate during the Phase 1 and 2 of the Movement Control Order (MCO) is still valid for Phase 3.

MITI encourages companies that received approval to submit a new application if they wish to obtain a new letter of approval with a QR Code which will facilitate the examination of their company's information when required by the authorities.

MITI also clarified that the (web) application system for companies to continue operation during the Phase 3 of the MCO - called the COVID-19 Intelligent Management System (CIMS) 2.0 - is currently being fine-tuned and upgraded. This exercise is being done through a collaborative effort from CyberSecurity Malaysia and several ICT industry players from the private sector.

MITI expects the system to resume operation at 3.00pm and would like to apologise for any inconvenience this may have caused during the previous system upgrade. Companies are encouraged to apply directly at via application.miti.gov.my, and not to MITI's website (www.miti.gov.my).

Please note that applications will not be accepted when the CIMS 2.0 system is down for maintenance, that is, from 12.00 am to 6.00 am daily.
