GOVERNMENT IS EVALUATING THE PROPOSAL TO ALLOW COMPANIES WITHIN CERTAIN SECTORS TO APPLY FOR APPROVAL TO OPERATE DURING THE MCO PERIOD

MITI had a meeting with various trade associations and chambers today. The Government is evaluating the proposal to allow companies within certain sectors to apply for approval to operate during the MCO period.

A decision on this matter will be announced soon, and the details and procedures for the applications by the approved sectors shall be disclosed accordingly.

In the meantime, companies that are interested, including companies that were rejected earlier, to apply for the above are **REQUIRED** to complete and submit the template in the links set out below by 10pm, TODAY (Thursday, 9.4.2020).

COMPANIES THAT DO NOT SUBMIT THE TEMPLATE BELOW MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR MITI'S APPROVAL.
