CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO 9 JUNE 2020

Reference is made to the [SPEECH BY YAB TAN SRI DATO' HAJI MUHYIDDIN, PRIME MINISTER OF MALAYSIA](#). Below are the highlights of YAB's speech.

1. The Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) will continue from 12 May until 9 June 2020 – for another four weeks.
2. The Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) under the CMCO would remain in effect until 9 June 2020. Any changes to the SOP or list of sectors that are allowed to operate will be notified.
3. Flexibility will be given to spouses for interstate travel for the purpose of meeting their families. Applications can be made via Gerak Malaysia App or at the nearest police station.
4. On Bantuan Prihatin Nasional (BPN) payments, the Minister of Finance (MOF) has agreed to extend the appeal period for BPN application until 31 May 2020. Applicants can appeal via email or at the Inland Revenue Board (IRB) counters starting Monday, 11 May 2020.
