**PERMISSION TO EXIT AND RETURN TO MALAYSIA**

Below are the **GUIDELINES FROM THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT OF MALAYSIA'S ON INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS OF PERSON UNDER SURVEILLANCE (PUS) EFFECTIVE 10 JULY 2020.**

1.	<p>Expatriate with an <b>ACTIVE PASS</b> who is currently in <b>MALAYSIA</b>, who desires to <b>LEAVE THE COUNTRY AND TO RETURN</b></p> <p>a) Employment Pass Category (EP I, II &amp; III) &amp; Residence Pass-Talent (RP-T)</p> <p>b) Professional Visit Pass (PVP)</p> <p>c) Dependants &amp; Foreign Maids for EP I, EP II &amp; RP-T</p> <p>d) Long Term Social Visit Pass (LT-SVP) for EP I, EP II &amp; RP-T</p>	<p>i. The applicant is required to obtain Permission to Exit Malaysia and Return from Expatriate Services Division (ESD)</p> <p>ii. The applicant has to submit for the Permission to Exit and Return to Malaysia via email to <a href="mailto:taskforce_esd@imi.gov.my">taskforce_esd@imi.gov.my</a></p> <p>iii. Upon receiving the Permission to Exit and Return Letter from ESD, the applicant is to provide the Letter at the entry point upon departure and entering Malaysia.</p> <p>iv. The applicant is allowed to exit Malaysia and <b>MUST</b> return within <b>SIXTY (60)</b> days from the issuance date of the letter.</p> <p>v. The applicant who wish to return to Malaysia is <b>REQUIRED</b> to undergo the <b>PCR Covid-19 Test</b> abroad within <b>THREE (3)</b> days, and must be medically confirmed and tested negative for Covid-19 prior to entering Malaysia.</p> <p>vi. It is also <b>COMPULSORY</b> for the expatriate to <b>DOWNLOAD AND INSTALL</b> the “MySejahtera” mobile application before departure. The “MySejahtera” application enables the Ministry of Health (MOH) to monitor users’ health conditions, and for them to be able to take immediate actions in providing the treatments required.</p> <p>vii. The applicant <b>MUST</b> undergo a <b>FOURTEEN (14)</b> day <b>SELF- QUARANTINE</b>.</p>

		<p>viii. The applicant will be required to undergo another <b>PCR Covid-19 Test</b> by the Ministry of Health (MOH). The cost of <b>PCR Covid-19 Test shall be borne</b> by the applicant.</p> <p>ix. The applicant is required to comply with the rules and regulations set by the Immigration Department of Malaysia.</p> <p>x. Permitted Malaysia Entry Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA)</li> <li>b. Immigration Checkpoint, Sultan Iskandar Building (BSI), Johor</li> <li>c. Sultan Abu Bakar Complex (2<sup>nd</sup> Link), Johor</li> </ul>
2.	Expatriate/PVP/RP-T/Dependents/LT-SVP/ Foreign Maids who is currently in <b>MALAYSIA</b> , and wish to <b>LEAVE THE COUNTRY FOR GOOD</b> . For example, contract ending/expiring in Malaysia/pass has been shortened.	i. Exempted to obtain Permission to Exit Malaysia from Expatriate Services Division (ESD).
