**MEMBERS ARE TO STRICTLY ADHERE TO THE STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES UNDER THE
CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER**

Reference is made to the [LETTER BY THE MINISTRY OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND INDUSTRY \(MITI\)](#) dated 26 November 2020.

MITI is requesting the commitment from employers to strictly adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) under the Conditional Movement Control (CMCO) to ensure the smooth operations of manufacturing activities.

The recent spike of positive COVID-19 cases in several clusters in Selangor and Penang involving the manufacturing sector had caught the attention of the Government. The Government is once again reminding employers to pay full attention to the health and welfare of their workers, particularly, on the housing, accommodation and amenities of the workers by adhering to the [REGULATIONS](#).

The Government has warned that the authorities would take immediate action to close the factory operations should any employers failed to adhere to the SOP or fail to provide full co-operation to the Ministry of Health (MoH) in preventing the spread of COVID-19.

MPMA calls upon all members for your full co-operation to strictly comply to the SOP to ensure the continuous uninterrupted business activities.
