TERMINATION OF ANTI-DUMPING INVESTIGATION ON IMPORTS OF POLYETHYLENE TEREPHTHALATE RESINS ORIGINATING FROM CHINA, INDONESIA, JAPAN, REPUBLIC OF KOREA, UNITED STATES AND VIETNAM

Reference is made to the [FEDERAL GOVERNMENT GEZETTE](#) dated **22 APRIL 2021**.

In the Final Determination of the anti-dumping investigation, the Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI) confirmed that the Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET) resins importing from China, Indonesia, Republic of Korea and Vietnam did not harm the PET resins industry in Malaysia and therefore the investigation is terminated.

MITI had initiated an anti-dumping investigation on imports of PET resins originating from China, Indonesia, Japan, Republic of Korea, United States (US) and Vietnam on 28 July 2020.

In its Preliminary Report dated 28 December 2020, MITI informed that the Government has found that there are sufficient evidences to continue with further investigation on the importation of the subject merchandise from China, Indonesia, Korea and Vietnam. Provisional anti-dumping duties up to 57.75% were imposed on PET resins importing from these countries. At the same time, the Government has also determined that the volume of imports of PET resins originating from Japan and the US to be negligible and therefore has terminated the anti-dumping investigation on both countries.

With the issuance of the Final Determination report on 22 April 2021, the anti-dumping investigation of PET resins importing from the six alleged countries has been totally terminated.
