

CIRCULAR NO. 67/2021

**OPERATION OF THE MANUFACTURING AND ITS RELATED SERVICES SECTORS DURING THE  
MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER FROM 1 – 14 JUNE 2021.**

Reference is made to the [PRESS RELEASE BY THE MINISTRY OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND INDUSTRY \(MITI\) DATED 30 MAY 2021](#).

1. Manufacturing and its related services sectors as listed in Appendix 1 are allowed to operate subject to the approval from MITI.
2. The letter - "Confirmation of Company Registration" can be downloaded from the Covid-19 Intelligent Management System (CIMS) 3.0 - <https://notification.miti.gov.my/>
3. Effective Sunday, 30 May 2021, 8.00 pm, manufacturing companies that have already registered with CIMS 3.0 are required to download the new MITI approval letter and where necessary, update their workers' list.
4. For manufacturing companies that have yet to register, submission can be made beginning Monday, 31 May 2021, 1.00 pm. Details on how to register at CIMS 3.0 (via [notification.miti.gov.my](http://notification.miti.gov.my)) can be accessed via [www.miti.gov.my](http://www.miti.gov.my).
5. To facilitate the movement of employees to/fro work, employees must carry at all times the MITI Confirmation of Company Registration from CIMS with QR Code, employee's identification tag or a letter from the employer stating details of the employee and with a statement indicating the purpose of travelling their movement to and from their work premises.
6. The Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for workforce capacity remains at 60% - refer to [MPMA'S CIRCULAR 65/2021](#).
7. Manufacturers in sectors allowed only for warm idle mode are subject to a maximum work force capacity of 10%.

Manufacturing and its related services sectors MUST ensure strict adherence to the SOPs by the National Security Council (NSC) and MITI. Any flaunting of, and non-compliance to the given SOPs will automatically lead to a compound and/or order to stop operations.

## APPENDIX 1

### LIST OF MANUFACTURING AND ITS RELATED SERVICES SECTORS ALLOWED TO OPERATE UNDER THE MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER FROM 1 – 14 JUNE 2021

#### **Capacity (60% workforce)**

1. Aerospace including maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO)
2. Food and beverage
3. Packaging and printing materials
4. Personal care products and cleaning supplies
5. Healthcare and medical care including dietary supplement
6. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) including rubber gloves, and fire safety equipment
7. Medical equipment components
8. Electrical and Electronics
9. Oil and Gas, including petrochemical and petrochemical products
10. Chemical products
11. Machinery and equipment
12. Textiles for manufacturing of PPE only
13. Production, distillation, storage, supply and distribution of fuels and lubricants

#### **Warm Idle (10% workforce)**

1. Automotive (vehicles and components)
2. Iron and Steel
3. Cement
4. Glass
5. Ceramic
