**'PROGRAM IMUNISASI INDUSTRI COVID-19 KERJASAMA AWAM SWASTA'  
FOR THE MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY**

Reference is made to the [MEDIA STATEMENT](#) by the Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI) and the [FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS](#) on the Public-Private Partnership Covid-19 Industry Immunisation Programme.

The 'Program Imunisasi Industri Covid-19 Kerjasama Awam-Swasta (PIKAS) will be launched as Phase 4 of the National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme (PICK). PICK will aim to accelerate immunisation of the rakyat and achieve herd immunity by increasing the vaccination uptake among the Malaysian workforce and reduce the number of Covid-19 workplace clusters.

PIKAS is a PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME supported by the private sector that will provide the usage of worksites, convention and exhibition centres as Pusat Pemberian Vaksin (PPV) that includes the services of both medical, non-medical and security personnel.

Highlights of the FAQ and some other pertinent points are as follows:

1. Companies from the manufacturing sector can apply under PIKAS starting **Sunday, 13 June 2021**. There is no deadline for PIKAS registration.
2. PIKAS participation is on voluntary basis and strictly for workers – both local and foreign - in the manufacturing sector. It cannot be extended to workers dependents, family members and close associates.
3. Companies can download the application form from MITI's website. The completed form may be submitted via the respective industry associations and business chambers of commerce to [vaccine4industry@miti.gov.my](mailto:vaccine4industry@miti.gov.my).

Companies that have previously registered need not resubmit their application.

4. It is a prerequisite for employees to register for PICK through MySejahtera before the company registers for PIKAS.

If an employee who has previously registered for vaccination received his/her vaccination, then he/she is not allowed to participate in the programme.

Contract workers will need to register for PICK under the respective company supplying contract work to the factory. The company supplying contract workers will then need to register for PIKAS.

5. Appointment information - such as the date and location of vaccination - will be notified to the employee via MySejahtera and SMS. Company representative registered in the application will be notified via email.

Once informed of the date of vaccination, companies are required to make the following arrangements:

- i. Confirm company's participation to the assigned PIKAS PPV venue operator.
  - ii. Formalise agreement with PIKAS PPV venue operator. To submit the signed agreement to the venue operator prior to the first vaccination date.
  - iii. Make full payment to the PIKAS PPV venue operator at least five working days before the vaccination date
  - iv. Arrange the necessary logistics for the workers to and from PIKAS PPV
6. Vaccination through PIKAS is implemented through two models – **MODEL 1 IS VACCINATION AT COMMON PPVS** (Convention Centres/Hotels) while **MODEL 2 REFERS TO ON-SITE VACCINATION WITHIN FACTORY PREMISE OR AT AN IDENTIFIED AND APPROVED LOCATION.**

Companies that have previously registered for on-site vaccination and want to opt for vaccination at common PPVs will need to submit a new application.

7. The Government through the Ministry of Health (MOH) will supply the vaccines FREE to the PPVs.
8. Types of vaccines given will be identified by Jawatankuasa Khas Jaminan Akses Vaksin (JKJAV) and based on location of the PPVs – either Pfizer, SinoVac or AstraZeneca. Candidates may refuse the type of vaccine to be administered after the registration process at the PPV not more than two times.

The company or a group of companies are allowed to identify suitable facilities for the PPV.

9. Conditions for ON-SITE VACCINATION are as follows:
  - i. Minimum 1,000 workers who have registered - may combine with other companies within the same locality to account for the 1,000 employees – and may be held over a period of a number of days.
  - ii. Companies with subsidiaries located in different states are not allowed to be grouped together in one PPV as no inter-state movement is permitted.
10. The criteria to set up a PPV on-site is as follows:
  - i. Able to accommodate up to 1,000 people per day
  - ii. Ample space to accommodate five main stations for PPV namely, Screening, Registration, Consultation, Vaccination and Monitoring.
  - iii. The proposed layout is as per the attached **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**
  - iv. Ensure the availability of ambulance for emergency purposes as recommended by the Covid-19 Immunisation Task Force (CITF)
  - v. Approved by CITF and MITI following on-site inspection.

The number of vaccines administered at the PPV will be subjected to availability and the number of medical officers (from the private sector) assigned at the on-site PPVs.

Company panel doctors can be appointed to administer the vaccines, provided that the panel of doctors are registered under ProtectHealth. For companies who do not have a panel doctor, ProtectHealth can also assist companies to identify doctors and nurses.

11. The breakdown of the estimated administration cost PER DOSE PER WORKER under Model 1 and 2 is as follows:

3.	PPV venue cost	RM30.00	Cost depends on the on-site venue preparation cost which will differ based on the size, layout and other costs to set up the venue.

*Note: Cost above is exclusive tax.*

12. All costs under this programme must be borne by the company. Employees should not be obliged to pay for the vaccination cost.

In the event the employee registered for PIKAS leaves the company, the company shall bear in full the administration cost for the employee's vaccination.
