**MYTRAVELPASS EXEMPTION FOR THE ENTRY OF FOREIGN CITIZENS  
WHO HAVE A LONG-TERM VISIT PASS TO MALAYSIA**

Reference is made to the [MALAYSIAN IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT'S MEDIA STATEMENT DATED 29 OCTOBER 2021](#).

Effective from 1 November 2021, the following would apply.

Foreign nationals holding Long-term Visit Pass in Malaysia under the following categories are allowed to enter Malaysia without having to obtain approval via the MyTravelPass (MTP)/MyEntry system from the Malaysian Immigration Department (JIM), provided they have a valid pass.

The following is a list of allowable Long-term Visit Passes to enter Malaysia without having to apply through MTP/MyEntry:

1. Diplomat (Exemption Order)/Dependent/Foreign Maid
2. Employment Pass (Category I, II, III)/Dependents/Foreign Maid
3. Resident Pass-Talent (RP-T)/Dependents/Foreign Maid
4. Professional Visit Pass - Specialist
5. Professional Visit Pass
6. Permanent Resident (PR)/Spouse to PR/Child to PR
7. Long-term Pass (Husband/Wife/Child) to Citizens
8. Senior Citizen Pass
9. Widow/Widower Pass to Citizens
10. Student/Dependent/Escort Pass
11. Malaysia Pass My Second Home (MM2H)/Dependents/Foreign Maid
12. Resident Pass
13. Temporary Working Visit Pass (PLKS)
14. Foreign Maid (PRA)

Foreign nationals under the following categories and who are not listed under the stated category as above would still need to apply through the MTP/MYEntry system for permission to enter Malaysia:

1. Social Visits
2. Holders of expired Long-term Visit Passes
3. Newly approved applications for Employment Pass (Category I, II, III)/Resident Pass-Talent (RP-T)/Dependents/Foreign Maid and Professional Visit Pass – Specialists
4. Short Term Business Travelers

The entry procedure upon arrival in Malaysia is still subject to the existing immigration rules that are still in force as well as health screening and quarantine procedures by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH).
