MALAYSIA AND SINGAPORE'S VACCINATED TRAVEL LANE-LAND (VTL-LAND)

Reference is made to the [PRESS STATEMENT](#) from the Prime Minister's Office dated 24 November 2021 on the Launch of Malaysia and Singapore's Vaccinated Travel Lane-Land (VTL-Land).

Highlights are as follows:

1. Both Governments are collaborating to launch the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) on 29 November 2021.
2. The **VTL-Land** initiative facilitates quarantine-free, seamless cross-border movement integrating health protocol, security, and immigration clearance.
3. Travellers allowed to take part in the VTL-Land are **Malaysia and Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents** and **holders of Malaysia and Singapore Long-Term Pass**.
4. The travellers must be fully vaccinated. For unvaccinated children below the age of 12, they must be accompanied by vaccinated parents or guardians.
5. Eligible travellers will be subjected to Covid-19 testing and further health requirements determined by the respective countries. Currently, the VTL-Land will be limited to **only bus transportation** as a control mechanism, and other modes of transportation will be included in stages.
6. VTL-Land bus services will use Larkin Sentral Bus Terminal (Larkin Sentral) as the boarding and disembarkation point in Malaysia while Queen Street Terminal (QST) will be used as boarding and disembarkation point in Singapore.
7. A daily quota not exceeding 1,500 travellers is set at initial stage with weekly increments.
8. Travellers coming into Malaysia using the VTL-Land will need to register at <https://mysafetravel.gov.my/>, while travellers from Malaysia to Singapore are required to register at <https://go.gov.sg/vtl-portal>.
9. This registration is compulsory **before any purchase of tickets is made**.
